DEPARTURES : Saturday and thursday

Day 1: arrival in cairo

Arrival at Cairo Airport, reception, assistance and transfer to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 2 : - The Pyramids of Giza - Egyptian Museum

Breakfast at the hotel. Hotel pickup by our guide. Enjoy your package in Egypt by visiting one of the seven wonders of the world (the pyramid of Cheops, the first and great Pyramid of King Jufu), the visit includes the other Pyramids of Giza: Khafre (the second Pyramid that is attributed to King Jafraa, son of King Jufu) and Micerinos (the third and smallest Pyramid of King Micerinos, son of King Jafraa and grandson of King Jufu); the Sphinx (with its lion's body and pharaoh's head) and the Valley Temple (built next to the Pyramid of Khafre). Your next stop is The Egyptian Museum which contains over 120,000 historical pieces from different eras of ancient Egyptian history. Among them we will know the history of the masterpieces that affected Egyptian history. You will also have the opportunity to visit a Papyrus Institute to see how the famous artwork is made. At the end of the visits return to your hotel and accommodation

Day 3 :Free day –Citadel – Bario Copto – Khan El Khalili – flight Cairo/ Luxor

Breakfast at the hotel Free day possibility to make the optional visits in Cairo with our professional Spanish-speaking guide. The first stop is at the Citadel of Saladin, a huge medieval fortress that has become Cairo's best-known non-pharaonic monument. Inside the Fortress we will enter the Mosque of Mohamed Ali, known as the Alabaster Mosque for the material that covers it. Its ornate decoration is spectacular, later The Coptic Quarter with the Suspended Church in its basilica structure, its old and symbolic pulpit, as well as its ancient frescoes. You can also see the church of St. Sergius refuge for the Holy Family when he fled from Herod. It ends with a walk through the Medieval Quarter of Khan el Khalili and its large Bazaar of handicrafts typical of Egypt. At the scheduled time. transfer to Cairo Airport to take flight to Luxor. Arrival and Reception on arrival, transfer to the CRUISE and embarkation.dinner on board and accommodation in Luxor.



Day 4 :Luxor

Breakfast on board, Enjoy an excursion in Luxor, crossing the Nile River to the West Bank of Luxor to visit the necropolis of the ancient city of Thebes. Transfer to the Valley of the Kings, where they buried the Pharaohic kings of the seventeenth to the twentieth century, their wives and the princes of royal blood in tumbs and cemeteries excavated in the rock of the mountains. Then you will visit The Temple of Queen Hachepsut, she was one of the women who reached power in ancient Egypt, the temple is one of the most outstanding monuments of Egypt, it is located in an area called El Deir El Baharí, which is a complex of temples and tombs that are on the western bank. On this shore you will also visit The Colossus of Memnon. In the afternoon you will visit the Eastern Bank to see some of the most outstanding temples in Egypt, which are The Temple of Karnak and The Temple of Luxor that were linked by an avenue of sphinxes. The temple of Karnak is the largest temple in Egypt, this temple contains inside The Great Temple of Amun and other small temples. Upon entering the temples of Karnak you will see each legacy left by the various pharaohs as a monumental complex. Afterwards you will visit the temple of Luxor, which was built by Amenofis III. It is a very beautiful temple. The walls and columns of this temple are decorated with intricate hieroglyphs. In front of this temple were two original obelisks but today you will see one of these obelisks, because the second is located in the center of the Place de la Concorde, in Paris. Lunch on board. Navigation to Edfu. Dinner and overnight on board.

Day 5: Edfu Temple/Komombo Temple

Breakfast on board. Transfer by horse carriage to visit the Temple of Horus, dedicated to the god Horus, is one of the best preserved temples in Egypt and was called Mesen, "The place of the harpoon", "The House of Ra". Navigation to KomOmbo. Lunch on board. Visit to the Temple of the god Sobek, an unusual building, completely symmetrical, with two entrances, two hypostyle rooms and two shrines. This is because it is dedicated to two gods: the left side to the falcon god Haroeris (Horus the old or the great) and the right to Sobek (local divinity with a crocodile head). Navigation to Aswan. Dinner and overnight on board.

Day 6: Aswan

The morning departure possibility of the OPTIONAL visit to the magnificent Temples of Abu Simbel In this excursion we will visit the amazing temples of Abu Simbel, the only monuments of Egypt that can compete with the three great pyramids of Giza. Return to the cruise and lunch, we will visit the Temple of Philaeo the temple of the goddess ISIS built in Greek times and transferred to Egelikia Island to save it from the waters of the Nile, Lunch and dinner on board and overnight on board in Aswan



Day 7: Flight Asuán / Cairo

Breakfast on board, and at the scheduled time Transfer to Aswan Airport to take the flight back to Cairo. Arrival and assistance at Cairo Airport. Transfer to the hotel and accommodation

Day 8: Cairo / Dubai

Breakfast ,At the predetermined time departure transfer to Cairo Airport. To take the flight to Dubai. Arrival at Dubai International Airport; after immigration procedures, reception with assistance from Spanish-speaking staff and transfer to the hotel; rest of the day free and accommodation.

Day 9:DUBÁI.

Breakfast.At the scheduled time departure to make Tour of Sharjah, The pearl of the gulf 22 km from the center of Dubai where you can see some architectural wonders built in the Arab style. Photo stop in the Qur'an square where you can admire a unique sculpture in the Islamic world of the Qur'an. Around ediciones where Arab architecture meets the modern city of Sharjah. Now we come to the key point of the tour, the visit of the Museum of Islamic Art and Civilization, a unique museum in the UAE, where the rise of Islamic civilization in science, medicine, mathematics and astronomy is highlighted. Then walk the heart of Sharjah (the big project of rebuilding the old Sharjah) where the Arab essence is lived in the Blue souk.

We will continue the visit to the city of Dubai knowing the past of the Dubaiites and the future. Starting with a panoramic stop at the Burj Al Arabic hotel; the most luxurious hotel in the world designed like a sail of the motorboats. Then stop at fotogra_far the first mosque built in Dubai; the Jumeirah mosque dating back to 1978. We headed to Dubai Mall to climb the Burj Khalifa tower, almeurzo, then we went to the Dubai museum to explore their pieces whose shape shows how they lived in the middle of nowhere but overcame the climatic circumstances and were able to engrave the name of their city with gold letters. Cross with Taxi Agua (Abra), to reach the market of species and the market of gold and free time to wander among its little shops and smell the fragrance enjoying the east with the seal of luxury; THE GOLD. Return to the hotel



Day 10: DUBÁI:

Free morning-Safari in the afternoon Breakfast at the hotel. Free morning to stroll or shop in one of the largest and most famous malls in the Emirates, such as Dubai Mall, with its fascinating 1200 shops of the most famous brands in the world, stroll through the new modern Walks of Dubai where you will take a space of creative lifestyle where you can live, work and play. Built around movement, exchange and community, here creativity thrives and everyone who visits is inspired to actively seek out the unexpected.

We will arrive at the capital of the United Arab Emirates: Abu Dhabi, the Manhattan of the Middle East and the administrative center of the country, we pass through the first link between the islands in Abu Dhabi; Al Maqtaa to see the SheikhZayed bridge built by renowned architect Zaha Hadad, visit the SheikhZayed Grand Mosque built in 2008, the third largest in the world, is distinguished by its magní_ca Islamic architecture and its pure white color; the white marble covers with all its facades and columns that are adorned with Qur'anic verses, and we continue towards the heart of the capital, then we enter the neighborhood of the sheikhs called AL BATEEN where the royal palaces and the residential palace of the current Sheikh president of the country are located; panoramic stop to appreciate hotel "Emirates Palace", most luxurious in the world, we will continue to the promenade known as "the Corniche" where you can take fantastic photos of the island arti_ of "Lulu" and the towers of Etihad to head towards the traditional village "HeritageVillage.
